The Bible is made up of different books: 66 in all. Each of these books has a name. And each book is divided into chapters and verses. This makes it easier to find different parts when we are looking for them.

The Bible has two main sections: the Old and New Testaments. The books of the Old Testament were written before Jesus. Jesus read these books and knew them by heart. The Old Testament was originally written in Hebrew. The Old Testament has 39 books. They are broken into four categories: the Torah, History, Poetry, and the Prophets.

The New Testament was written after the resurrection of Jesus. It was originally written in Greek. There are 27 books in the New Testament. The New Testament is divided into three categories: Gospels, History, and Letters.
