- The Bible is made up of 66 different books. Each of these books is divided into chapters and verses.
- The Bible has two main sections: the Old Testament and the New Testament. The Old Testament was written before Jesus and contains 39 books. These books are divided into four categories: the Torah, History, Poetry, and the Prophets.
- The New Testament was written after the resurrection of Jesus. It contains 27 books in three sections: Gospels, History, and Letters.
